New ORCA Plus

What is ORCA Plus?

ORCA Plus is a discount ORCA card offered exclusively to eligible Seattle Community College students.

An eligible student is one that pays the TMP fee. If you are required to pay TMP, you are eligible for the subsidy.

You pay \$125 and receive a \$200 value!

How does it work?

Each ORCA card is loaded with a value of \$200 and operates like a debit card. You can "pay as you go" and/or use the card to purchase transit products catered to your specific needs. To use, simply tap your card when you board the bus or train and your fare will be deducted from the balance of your card immediately.



Can I purchase a Regional Transit Pass with my ORCA Plus?

Can I add more value to an ORCA Plus?

Yes. Your ORCA Plus is reloadable beyond the original purchase value.
