

**Associate of Arts Articulation Agreement between
Seattle College District
And
Tokyo International University**

To create a clear and easy pathway for students of the Seattle College District (SCD), consisting of North Seattle College, South Seattle College and Seattle Central College, to transfer to and complete their Bachelor Degree at Tokyo International University (TIU). This transfer agreement outlines transfer requirements, provisions, and related advertising considerations. This agreement does not guarantee admission to the university or to the specific program/major.

1. Upon completion of the Associate of Arts degree (A.A.) degree at the Seattle Colleges, students will be accepted by TIU at junior status with 90 quarter transfer credits that will be converted to 62 credits at TIU. Transferring students must have a minimum cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.5. Courses numbered lower than 100-level are not included in this transfer agreement. In the event students do not complete the entire A.A. degree at the Seattle Colleges, applications must be made as a freshman.
2. In completion of the degree specified above, students will have met all Academic Literacy and Liberal Arts general education requirements at TIU. However, 16 credits of Japanese language courses will be required for graduation. This language requirement may be waived for students who already possess a sufficient level of Japanese proficiency.
3. Applicants from the Seattle Colleges will be required to be screened by TIU under the conditions specified in the English Track Program Application Guideline for Transfer Students. International Students must submit a valid English test score report in accordance to the requirements in the aforementioned guideline.
4. SCD and Tokyo International University may choose to co-develop written materials outlining for SCD students programs, policies and procedures relevant to this agreement. This agreement will be publicized in newsletters, course schedules and other promotional materials upon prior approval by TIU.

This agreement will remain in effect until a mutually agreed-upon change is deemed necessary and may be terminated by the SCD or Tokyo International University with appropriate written notification. Each institution agrees to provide termination notice 90 days prior to the intended change.

SCD and Tokyo International University officially authorize this agreement on the 1st Day of April, 2018, with the agreement becoming effective immediately.
