Per SBCTC, these are the four categories of employees:

Classified Support Staff

Support staff who work under a set of conditions established by civil service rules or collective bargaining agreements.

Professional/Technical

This category includes managers of college programs. Also included is non-managerial professional staff such as counseling/advising specialists, student placement coordinators, and principal assistants to chief

Administrative

Includes the chief officers, vice presidents, deans and associate deans in instruction and student services, and directors of major programs. This group is exempt from the jurisdiction of the civil service system and

Faculty

Includes teaching and non-teaching employees. Non-teaching employees include counselors and librarians.
